## Statement of Significant Changes- Yorkshire Water Services Ltd – Charges 2017-18

The company is not expecting there to be any bill increases of more than 5% from the previous year for a given customer type assuming a constant level of consumption.

- No individual customer in Yorkshire should experience a total water and sewerage bill increase of more than 5%.
- The application of wholesale revenue forecasting incentive mechanism (WRFIM) in 2017-18 has resulted in a reduction of £5.6m on the wholesale water revenue allowance. The adjustment is due to the over recovery of revenue in 2015-16.
- There has been no significant change in the charging policy by the company between 2016-17 and 2017-18.
