As part of our work to increase stormwater storage and improve water quality in the River Wharfe, we'll be carrying out essential improvement works on Low Mill Lane, Addingham. This work will once again be carried out by our contract partners from M Group.

These works will require a full 24-hour road closure for a period of two weeks, from 5 January 2026 to 19 January 2026.

This closure has been approved by Bradford Council and it's needed to make sure residents and workers are safe while we carry out critical infrastructure upgrades.

We understand that a full closure will cause disruption, and we're speaking with residents to help prevent major impacts. **If you have access needs or concerns about access during this period, please contact us as soon as possible** so we can try to help you get to where you need to be, or to make sure your visitors can reach you.

The upcoming work will help add additional sewage storage capacity to help improve the water quality of the river Wharfe. A new chamber is being built within the road to link the existing sewer system with a 700-metre pipeline. This pipeline will connect to the current combined sewer overflow, which is being enhanced with a stormwater tank to better manage heavy rainfall events. The tank is in our existing works site.
