We refer to your request for information submitted to Yorkshire Water dated 24 September 2025:

"However, it is evident that there are residential areas, particularly Yeadon, Horsforth and Cookridge, that are situated adjacent to the airport's perimeter and thus are highly likely to be affected by surface water runoff from LBA, which may in turn make its way into surface water drains overseen by Yorkshire Water. Consequently, we have two further supplementary questions to the six in our original FOI request:

- 1. Does Yorkshire Water ever use treated surface water from northwest Leeds (in particular Yeadon, Horsforth and Cookridge/Tinshill) or divert water from rivers downstream of the airport to supplement drinking water supplies (even if only during drought periods)?
- 2. You mentioned in your response to question 5 that "A small number of the Company's sites have demonstrated Tier 2 levels of PFAS..." Are any of these sites in a location where it is possible that the airport is the source of the PFAS contamination? "

Included with this email is our response to your question. There is no element of run off from Leeds Bradford Airport that enters the treatment stream and this is

what we mean when we say that the Airport is not in the catchment for any of our sites.

We trust that the provision of this data satisfies your request. In accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, if you are not satisfied with this reply to your request you can ask for an internal review. A request for an internal review must be submitted within 40 working days by contacting the Data Protection Team.
