I refer to your request for information submitted to Yorkshire Water dated 27 January 2025.

In relation to the location data when reviewing the information that you have requested, we are satisfied that the information amounts to personal data and should not be disclosed under Regulation 12(3) and 13. We are satisfied that the disclosure of the information you have requested in relation to this would allow the identification of an identifiable individual(s). Secondly, disclosure of this information would contravene principle a, of the Data Protection Act 2018 and GDPR, as there is no lawful basis for this processing. Based on this we will not be able to provide all the information you have sought.

We have provided below records of the work that has been completed on More Hall Lane and Sunny Bank Road in Sheffield:

**03.08.20218 - Insp-Emergency Burst/Leak**

Burst main in road on Sunny Bank Road. Water showing but not severe.

**22.11.2018 – Insp-Emergency Burst/Leak**

Work raised to repair leak on main in highway.

**16.01.2020 - Burst / Leak Inspection**

No leaks onsite, only water is surface water coming of hills.

**15.04.2018 - Burst / Leak Inspection**

No burst, surface water issue.

**26.04.2024 –Burst / Leak Inspection**

Attended burst inspection, water running down road and this seems to be land water as it is running from a culvert drain into the carriageway from the fields which are at a high elevation. Sample taken and proved to be land water. Work completed.

**01.07.2024 –Burst / Leak Inspection**

This is ground water running from underneath an ancient, naturally filled stone trough. Raised work to reattend in a month to see if it's drying up over the drier months.

**24.01.2025 - Emergency Burst / Leak Inspection**

Main repair raised
