I refer to your request for information submitted to Yorkshire Water dated 25 February regarding:

- 1. The total acreage involved in this development and whether it is all on the flood plain.*
- 2. Whether any flood attenuation has been planned or already delivered to compensate for the loss of flood plain.*
- 3. To what extent has Dewsbury Sewerage Treatment Works been enlarged to deal with the additional burden which will be placed upon it by this development.*
- 4. On the assumption that SuDS will be deployed where will surface water be directed to."*

Please find attached the data which you have requested.

1.The total acreage involved in this development and whether it is all on the flood plain.

3. To what extent has Dewsbury Sewerage Treatment Works been enlarged to deal with the additional burden which will be placed upon it by this development.

In AMP7 there have been several capital schemes at Dewsbury (Mitchell Laithes) STW to deal with increased flow/loads and tightening standards, including:

- Storm tank capacity increased by 5000cu.m
- Construction of 1 no. Primary distribution chamber
- Construction of 3no. 45m diameter radial primary settlement tanks with full width scraper bridges.
- Installation of primary chemical dosing plant consisting of 2 no. 40cu.m chemical storage tanks, dosing pumps and ancillaries.

4. On the assumption that SuDS will be deployed where will surface water be directed to.

The data protection team have conversed with the business and have established we do not hold any of the requested data. As such for the purposes of paragraph 12(4) a public authority may refuse to disclose information to the extent that (a) it does not hold that information when an applicant's request is received.
