We refer to your request for information submitted to Yorkshire Water dated 27 August 2025:

"Doing some local history research and recently came across references suggesting that Yorkshire Water built 10 emergency control bunkers during the Cold War era (around the 1980s/1990s). He is fascinated by this aspect of regional history and was hoping you might be able to help.

Would you be able to share any general information about these sites—particularly:

The locations or general areas where the bunkers were situated

Whether they were purpose-built facilities or conversions of basements

Any information on whether any of these sites still exist, or if they've been sold, repurposed, or demolished"

Included with this email is the response to your question. In consulting with the business we have been unable to locate any records related to your request. As such for the purposes of paragraph 12(4) a public authority may refuse to disclose information to the extent that (a) it does not hold that information when an applicant's request is received.

We trust that the provision of this data satisfies your request. In accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, if you are not satisfied with this reply to your request you can ask for an internal review.
