"I have been looking through the data you provided and noticed that only the 8 WWTP (table below) have regulatory sampling data whereas 27 WWTP are in the PE/MCERT table.

Please could you confirm that regulatory data is not available for the remaining 19 WTTP.

To clarify the map, I sent with site locations are not where I assumed a treatment plant to be, but where I took my project river water samples from, the sites were mostly selected due to ease of public access, safe sampling location.

Also for the flow data I noticed that the sites below are not measured at work outlet, please could you clarify if the flow at the stage is equivalent to flow to the river or is there some time delay if it is before a final treatment, if so how would this be calculated.

Internal review response EIR:

All of the flow data provided is from the designated MCERT flow monitoring point for the Sewage Treatment Works, which are monitors in a suitable location to be representative of the total treated flow being discharged to river. Often these will be at the outlet of the treatment works, but they can also be located at the inlet or mid process as long as they remain representative of the total daily volume being treated and discharged which is assessed as part of the MCERT inspection. If correctly located then the measured flow will be the same at the inlet and outlet over the course of the day when producing the total daily average flow.

Please see attached spreadsheets for the further sites highlighted in your table the results since OSM/UWW samples results since 2020.

Thank you for clarifying that the map you sent indicated your project river water sampling locations and not the assumed treatment sites. Upon reviewing your original request, we realise we misinterpreted your inquiry and believed the map highlighted assets of interest. As a result, the information we provided was based on this.
