### **1. SOURCE OF SUPPLY**

- 1.1 Inland water known as Silsden Beck, Stilling – basin at foot of Silsden Reservoir embankment.

### **2. POINTS OF ABSTRACTION**

- 2.1 At National Grid Reference SE 045 479 at the point marked "A" on the map.

### **3. MEANS OF ABSTRACTION**

- 3.1 Pump.

### **4. PURPOSE OF ABSTRACTION**

- 4.1 Public Water Supply.

### **5. LAND ON WHICH LICENCE AUTHORISES USE OF WATER**

- 5.1 Area not specified by virtue of Section 46, subsection (4) of the Water Resources Act 1991.

### **6. PERIOD OF ABSTRACTION**

- 6.1 All Year.

### **7. MAXIMUM QUANTITY OF WATER TO BE ABSTRACTED DURING THE SPECIFIED PERIOD**

Note: an hour means any period of 60 consecutive minutes, a day means any period of 24 consecutive hours and a year means the 12 month period beginning on 1 January and ending on 31 December.

## **SCHEDULE OF CONDITIONS (continued)**

- 7.2 In emergency, when repairs are being carried out to the Barden aqueduct, this licence authorises the temporary abstraction from the Silsden Reservoir for supply to silsden or to the Gilstead filtration works, of the following amounts in aggregate

2,273                  cubic metres per day

### **8. MEANS OF MEASUREMENT OR ASSESSMENT OF WATER ABSTRACTED**

- 8.1 The quantity of water abstracted in virtue of this licence shall be measured by a meter, such meter to be read monthly, and the quantity recorded by the meter shall be taken to be the quantity of water abstracted.

- 8.2 The Licence Holder shall fix and maintain a measuring notch or weir at the exit from the stilling – basin into Silsden Beck, together with a gauge board to show the depth of water flowing over the notch or weir and marked at levels corresponding to flows of 3,318.64 cubic metres per day and 2,409.42 cubic metres per day.

### **9. FURTHER PROVISIONS**

- 9.1 No water shall be abstracted from the stilling – basin when the flow over the notch or weir is less than 2,409.42 cubic metres per day.
