We refer to your request for information submitted to Yorkshire Water dated 2 June 2025:

"We would like to make a FOI for the sewage status records from 2000 to present for Thornton Beck at Thornton in Craven"

We wrote to you on the 6 June 2025 to clarify your request, you responded on the 9 June 2025 to confirm you require information on Thornton Beck SPS:

- total discharge spills
- dates and times

We contacted you again on the 23 June 2025 to confirm that we had been unable to locate the above asset and asked if there was any further information you could provide to help us identify the asset for which you requested the information. You responded to advise Thornton Beck at Thornton in Craven SPS.

Please find attached the data which you have requested. Within our acknowledgement we confirmed whilst we processed your request that there is information available in the public domain in relation to our Event Duration Monitoring (EDM):

- Our 2020 to 2023 data is available in the public domain via our EIR disclosure log from a previous request

- Our 2024 data is available in the public domain via our webpage titled [Individual stop start events 2024](#)
- Our 2025 data is being published in the public domain one month in arrears via our webpage titled [Individual stop start events 2025 year to date](#)

Confirming if there have been discharges at Thornton in Craven SPS during 2020 to 2025 (one month in arrears), this will be recorded within this information with the start and stop times and duration of each event.

In addition to this, please see attached the 12/24 summary data for the period of 2020 to 2024. We do not hold the 12/24 summary data for 2025 as this work will be completed in 2026. As such for the purpose of EIR we applied exemption 12(4)(a), a public authority may refuse to disclose information to the extent that it does not hold that information when an applicant's request is received.

We can confirm that Event Duration Monitoring (EDM) was installed at Thornton in Craven SPS in 2019 but did not report until 2020. Therefore the EDM data within the

public domain is the data that is available for this site. As a result of this we do not hold the data you request for the site for the years 2000 to 2019. As such for the purpose of EIR we applied exemption 12(4)(a), a public authority may refuse to disclose information to the extent that it does not hold that information when an applicant's request is received.

We trust that the provision of this data satisfies your request. In accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, if you are not satisfied with this reply to your request you can ask for an internal review. A request for an internal review must be submitted within 40 working days by contacting the Data Protection Team.
