I refer to your request for information submitted to Yorkshire Water dated 10 April 2026:

“It is my understanding that Water Authorities now have to test for a full suite of PFAS.

Please provide all the test results for

1. Embsay Reservoirs North Yorkshire

2. High Bentham Service Reservoirs

3. Yorkshire Water owned Boreholes in Clapham North Yorkshire”

Please find attached the data you requested. Please see attached Embsay reservoir PFAS data, treated water sampling is completed on a risk basis, so only higher risk sources have treated water samples taken.

Embsay WTW is in tier 1 (from the DWI PFAS guidance) and is classified as low risk for PFAS from the raw water sources and therefore there are no treated water PFAS results for High Bentham service reservoirs.

We do not sample for PFAS at service reservoirs and we do not own any boreholes or have any abstraction points at Clapham.

The information in the attached covers 2026.
