DIY mini Water Butt!

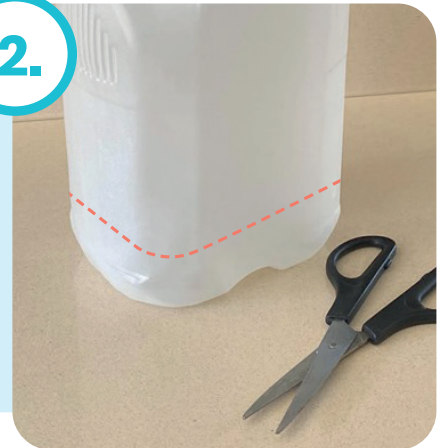
Clean your carton ☐

Grab your milk carton (make sure it's empty first!), remove the label. Give it a good clean and dry it well.

Cut off the base ☐

Now very carefully cut off the base close to the bottom. You might want to ask an adult to give you a helping hand here!

Decorate ☐

Using your best arts and crafts skills, make your bottle stand out! Turn it into a garden animal, give it a cool water saving theme or just paint it your favourite colour!

Hang outside ☐

Show off your creation and attach your water butt to a fence in your garden, with some gardening string. Make sure the cap is on and pointing down, so you can catch rainwater!
