I refer to your request for information submitted to Yorkshire Water dated 12 February regarding:

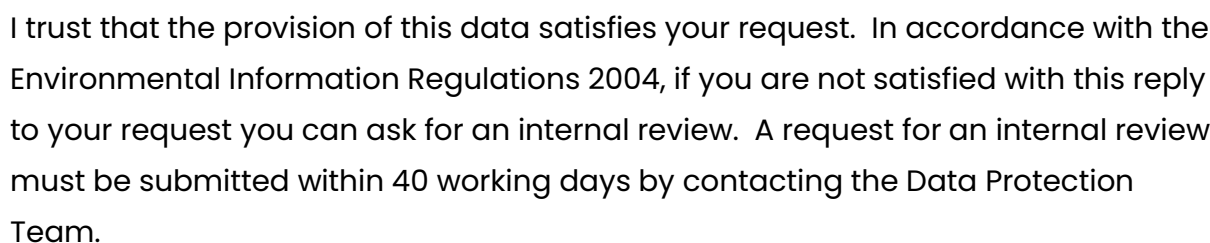
“The information provided does not include the impermeable area catchment served by the combined sewers nor does the information include an capacity information for the sewers in the area of pickering.”

Please find below the data which you have requested.

77% of the sewer length in the catchment is classified as foul/combined, flows in these sewers go to the sewerage treatment works. The catchment covers a total of 226ha with around 12% of this being Impermeable area that is considered to directly connect to either the foul combined or storm systems. 2/3 of this impermeable area connects to the FC system. There will be additional, slower rainfall driven responses from permeable area, although there is no formal connection from theses spaces into the sewer system.

This is all based on hydraulic model results which makes use of spot survey information alongside, interpolation and engineering judgement to fill in any
