We refer to your request for information submitted to Yorkshire Water dated 2 July 2025:

“For information regarding sampling of York drinking water for PFAS levels.”

Included with this email is a link to the PFAS data available in the public domain via our EIR disclosure log: [PFAS treated data.csv](#)

You will need to filter the data for Acomb Landing WTW which supplies York. For Acomb Landing Water Treatment Works (WTW) treated water, all individual PFAS compound sample results are within tier 1. There are no tier 3 PFAS detections and Yorkshire Water follows the latest guidance from the Drinking Water Inspectorate (DWI) for PFAS.

We would like to clarify that the specific chemical identified in the testing in France is not currently required under the instruction of Drinking Water Inspectorate in England and Wales. We will, of course, follow all guidance should it be modified in future.

We trust that the provision of this data satisfies your request. In accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, if you are not satisfied with this reply to your request you can ask for an internal review. A request for an internal review must be submitted within 40 working days by contacting the Data Protection Team.
