We refer to your request for Environmental information submitted to Yorkshire Water dated 2 April 2026:

“Please provide all records held relating to:

- 1. Any intensive pig farming installations housing more than 750 breeding sows or 2,000 production pigs over 30kg operating within 2km of any Yorkshire Water owned land, water abstraction points, reservoirs, treatment works or waterways*
- 2. Any water quality concerns, incidents or monitoring data relating to watercourses near intensive pig farming installations in your supply area in the last five years*
- 3. Any correspondence between Yorkshire Water and the Environment Agency, Natural England or any local authority regarding intensive pig farming near your infrastructure or water sources”*

The data protection team have conversed with the business and have established we do not hold any of the requested data. As such for the purposes of paragraph 12(4) a public authority may refuse to disclose information to the extent that (a) it does not hold that information when an applicant’s request is received.

We trust that the provision of this data satisfies your request. In accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, if you are not satisfied with this reply to your request you can ask for an internal review. A request for an internal review must be submitted within 40 working days by contacting the Data Protection Team.
