I refer to your request for information submitted to Yorkshire Water dated 9 March for the following information in relation to Kirk Hammerton WwTW:

"The approximate number of tanker or lorry movements to and from the Kirk Hammerson WwTW on an average day or week.

Whether these vehicles are primarily removing waste from the site or delivering waste to the site.

If waste is being delivered to the works, what types of waste are accepted and where it typically originates from.

Whether any waste or sludge removed from the site is typically transported for further treatment or disposal"

Please find attached the data which you have requested.

Tanker movements to and from Kirk Hammerson Wastewater Treatment Works are limited and predominantly planned. There are scheduled tanker visits approximately twice per week; any additional visits beyond this are on an ad hoc basis and are not routine. The site is attended seven days a week by operational colleagues to ensure the works continues to operate

safely and in accordance with required operating standards. All tanker movements relate to the removal of sludge from the site. No waste is delivered to Kirk Hammerson Wastewater Treatment Works. Sludge removed from the site is typically transported to Ripon Sewage Treatment Works, where it undergoes further treatment.

I trust that the provision of this data satisfies your request. In accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, if you are not satisfied with this reply to your request you can ask for an internal review. A request for an internal review must be submitted within 40 working days by contacting the Data Protection Team.
