A duty under the Act only applies if two or more existing domestic premises (built before 20th June 1995) are found to cause adverse effects and the provision of a public sewer for domestic purposes is the most appropriate solution.

The local parish or District Council's Environmental Health Department can also make an application on behalf of the whole community.

On submission of this application form, please ensure that you attach all relevant documentation to support your application.

Please ensure that you provide a covering letter with your application detailing any site specific information.

What happens next?

You will receive an acknowledgment letter within five calendar days confirming receipt of your application.

We will undertake an initial assessment of your application and provide you with a response within 28 calendar days.

We may also require a site visit within this initial assessment period to support your application. If so, we will make contact with you to arrange this.
